- Knowledge of SCADA/HMI applications, knowledge of Citect is an advantage as many old projects are built with it;
- Willingness to learn the new SCADA software Lynx and willing to actively contribute to its improvement;
- Both working in a team and working independently on projects appeals to you;
- Clear communication in Dutch and English
- You are allowed to work in the Netherlands.
