You are given the freedom to chart your own course. Once on board, you dive straight into specialized and challenging work. Using your expertise, you track down the fault, replace the part, and test the system. When the systems are running flawlessly again and the ship can depart safely, it gives a huge thrill. You did it again!

What will you be doing?

As a Service Engineer, you bring state-of-the-art maritime technology to life on board a wide variety of vessels. You install and configure advanced NavCom systems such as radars, gyrocompasses, and ECDIS installations, and ensure that all hardware and software run flawlessly. For example, when a radar antenna jams, satellite communication stops working, or electronics malfunction, you dig into the complex fault until it is resolved. On board, you are the expert: you advise the captain and the crew on the use of their high-tech equipment. Finally, through accurate reports and certifications, you ensure that the ship officially complies with all international legislation and can leave the port safely.
