Of course you will be well trained first. When you are done with your job, you discuss with your client what you have done. Is your customer satisfied? Then you are also satisfied!

### What are you going to do?

- Perform maintenance on navigation/communication equipment
- Troubleshooting
- Commissioning of the equipment on board

It can happen that your schedule for the day is empty in the morning. Then you go to work in the workshop. But it can happen that your schedule fills up with challenging jobs.
